

## MICHELIN® X® TWEEL® UTV AIRLESS RADIAL TIRE GUIDELINES FOR PROPER USE



### WARNING

Tires that are designated as NHS (Not for Highway Service) must not be used in highway service. Using NHS tires in highway service may result in tire failure which can lead to an accident and serious personal injury or death.

**NOTE: MICHELIN® X® TWEEL® UTV airless radial tires are rated NHS (NOT for Highway Service).**

### ACTION REQUIRED

Michelin® X Tweel® UTV airless radial tires are specifically designed for ATVs/UTVs. These follow the Tire & Rim Association's NHS (Not for Highway Service) tire design standard and are for ATV/UTV use only. The Tire & Rim Association defines NHS as "Tires primarily designed for use outside of public roads, but suitable for temporary / incidental use on public roads." Please refer to U.S. Tire Manufacturers Tire Information – Misapplication of "Not for Highway Service (NHS)" Tires – presented below.

### Misapplication of "Not for Highway Service (NHS)" Tires

Tires are designed and manufactured for specific conditions of use and service. Tires that have NHS in the tire size designation are designed for off highway applications. **They must not be used for normal highway service.** NHS tires are not intended for speeds, temperatures or stresses of highway use. They are intended for farm, off-road, lawn and garden, and industrial use.



Federal regulations require that all tires designed and certified for highway service have the symbol "DOT" molded on the tire sidewall adjacent to the tire identification number. Consult the tire manufacturer or tire service professionals for information regarding the use of a particular tire.

### MICHELIN® X® TWEEL® UTV Airless Radial Tire Usage

TWEEL® UTV airless radial tires are not DOT approved. Some counties and states in the USA allow ATVs/UTVs to be used on public roads. A DOT approved tire is not currently required by the counties and states in the USA that allow the use of an ATV/UTV on public roads.

Please consult local or state laws for using your ATV/UTV on public roads.
